AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021



- \$1.9 Trillion Total
- \$350 Billion to states and local governments
- > \$195 billion for states and the District of Columbia
- \$130 billion for local governments
 - *\$65 billion for counties
 - *\$45.5 billion for "metro cities" (50,000 and

higher)

*Non-entitlement units (under 50,000) get funding from states

ELIGIBLE EXPENDITURES: EXAMPLES



- 1. Impacted Industries (tourism, travel, hospitality)
- 2. Small business support (loans, grants, counseling)
- Hardest hit communities
 (investing in socioeconomic disparities)

- 4. Public health (includes mental health, outreach efforts)
- 5. Aid to nonprofits
- 6. Broadband and digital literacy
- 7. Shuttered venues

Local governments can provide funds to community nonprofits, businesses and organizations for eligible expenses.
