








2020 Congressional Calendar

FY 2021 Appropriations Process


- FY 2020 was largely a bipartisan process, with both parties and the President coming to a two-year spending agreement
- President's FY 2021 Budget Request—already submitted to Congress
- House began some Appropriations subcommittee hearings
- 302(b) numbers released by Chairwoman Nita Lowey (D-NY)
- Currently, appropriations process has been suspended due to Congress' focus on COVID-19
- FY 2021 Begins on October 1, 2020
